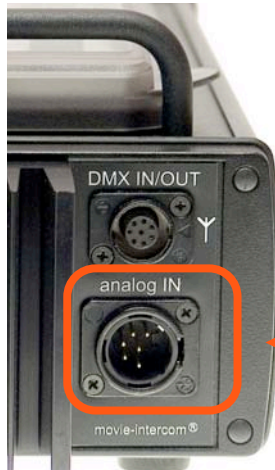

Actor-controlled lighting with sensors

A sensor can synchronize a lighting effect of a switched practical or candle flame with film lighting connected at the LFXHub.

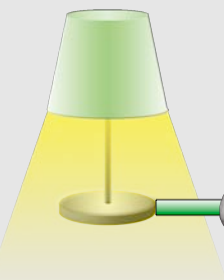

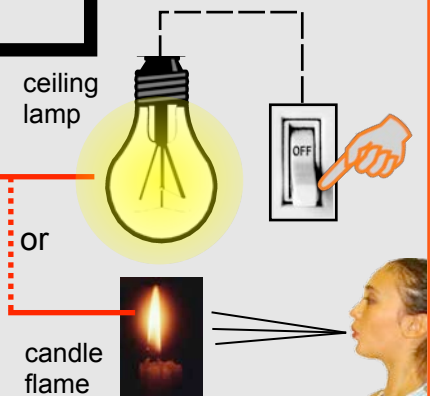

Set rotary switch "EFFECT" to position "analog IN".

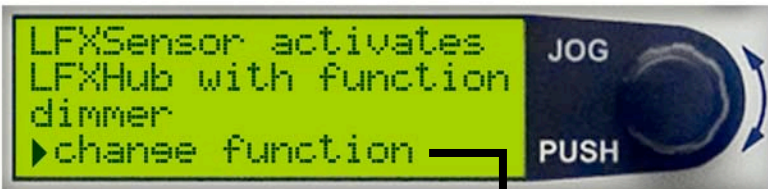
A plugged-in sensor is automatically identified. Then the display will show the infos shown below.



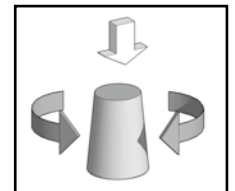

Select a **function** with the JOG, standard setting is "dimmer".

When a sensor sends an active signal to the LFXHub this function will be activated.
